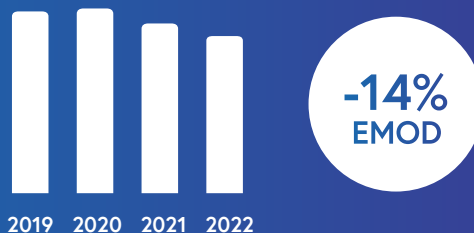
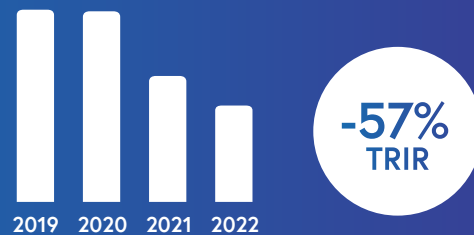

Challenge

- Tracking and improving safety behavior across nine companies and 3,500+ employees was difficult
- Hand-written forms made reporting of incidents laborious
- Paper-based system made visibility into safety behaviors difficult

Solution

- Implement Safety Mojo company wide to increase engagement of frontline supervisors and managers
- Use Safety Mojo's real-time dashboard to track leading indicators.
- Access real-time data to execute continuous safety improvement

Results

- Overall improvement in safety through consistent expectations, tracking, and follow-up
- 57% reduction in TRIR
- 14% decrease in EMOD
